The position involves grinding and fabricating sheet metal assemblies. The operator must produce good quality parts while working to an hourly production rate. Packaging is also required. Other miscellaneous tasks throughout the shop may be required depending on the workload. Adheres to the QMS requirements.

- Ability to read prints, weld symbols, and written instructions
- Ability to use basic inspection equipment to verify part quality and record inspection data Ability to interpret drawings and welding symbols

- Must be able to lift metal parts to load and unload fixtures or tools.
