

## MIG/TIG Welder

## Overview/Responsibilities

The position involves welding and fabricating sheet metal assemblies with and without fixtures. The operator must produce good quality parts while working to an hourly production rate. Grinding and packing is also required. Other miscellaneous tasks throughout the shop may be required depending on the workload. Adheres to the QMS requirements.

- Ability to read prints, weld symbols, and written instructions
- Ability to use basic inspection equipment to verify part quality and record inspection data Ability to interpret drawings and welding symbols
- Ability to read, write, and speak English
- Must be able to lift metal parts to load and unload fixtures or tools. Some grinding and packing is required. Must work efficiently to a production rate, while making good quality parts for an 8-hour shift. Standing all day while welding is common.
- Robotic welding experience is a plus
